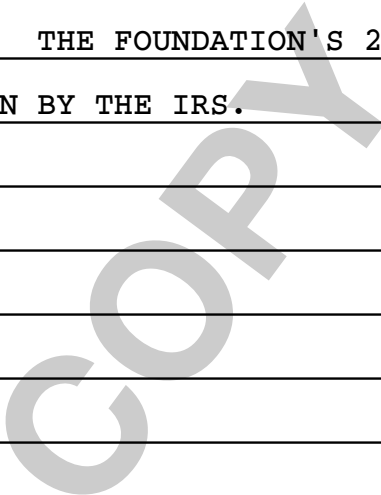

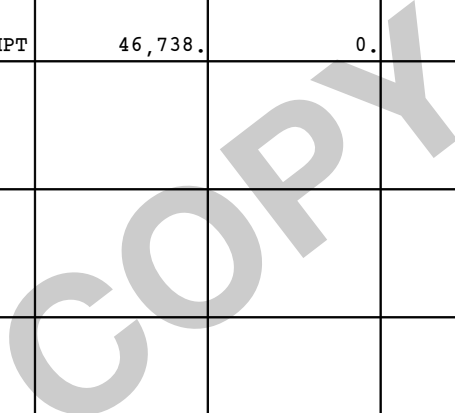

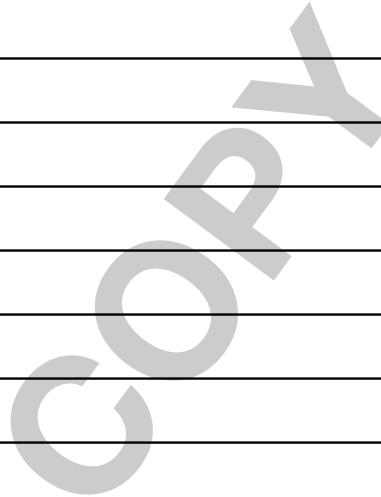

STAFF ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A FORM STATING THEY HAVE READ AND AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE POLICY. THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES ENSURES THAT EACH EMPLOYEE HAS COMPLETED A SIGNED FORM BY THE END OF FEBRUARY FOLLOWING THE JANUARY MEETING.

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2. ANNUALLY, THE BOARD REVIEWS THE POLICY, GENERALLY AT THEIR FEBRUARY MEETING OR DURING THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY. BOARD MEMBERS NOT IN ATTENDANCE AT THE PARTICULAR MEETING ARE CONTACTED BY A MEMBER OF SENIOR MANAGEMENT AND ASKED TO REVIEW THE POLICY.

3. NEW STAFF AND BOARD MEMBERS RECEIVE THE POLICY WITH THEIR ORIENTATION MATERIALS. THEY SIGN AND RETURN THE FORM STATING THEY HAVE READ AND AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE POLICY.

4. NON-BOARD MEMBERS OF BOARD COMMITTEES REVIEW THE POLICY UPON JOINING THE COMMITTEE AND THEN ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, ALSO IN FEBRUARY. THEY ALSO SIGN AND RETURN THE FORM STATING THEY HAVE READ AND AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE POLICY.

5. FOUNDATION CONSULTANTS ARE GIVEN THE EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF THE POLICY AS PART OF THE INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT.

THE COMMITTEE ALSO REVIEWS THE CEO'S CURRENT BASE SALARY, THE FOUNDATION'S CURRENT AND PROPOSED PAY RANGE FOR THE POSITION AND CONSULTS WITH THE THIRD PARTY CONSULTANT TO ENSURE THAT THE COMMITTEE HAS FULL PERSPECTIVE IN PROPOSING AN ADJUSTMENT IN PAY.

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE SESSION ARE KEPT PRIVATELY BUT MADE AVAILABLE UPON DEMAND.

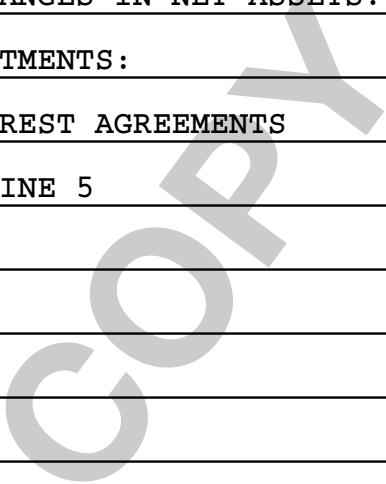
